RULES

1. Open to all residents of Ratley and Edgehill with Upton and Camp Lane; plus visiting children who are relatives of residents of the Parish, or those who work in the Parish or who have a parish allotment.
2. Exhibits must be the property of and/or the unaided work of the exhibitor.
3. Craft items/photographs not to have been exhibited previously at Ratley & District Show.
4. Pot plants must have been in the exhibitor's possession for a minimum period of six months.
5. All Judges are independent of the Flower Show committee. The awarding of points will be at the Judges' discretion alone. The Judges' decision will be final.
6. Entry forms/cash **only** to be handed in by **Wednesday 17th August** to Monika Morgan, 3, Grange Close Or at the Village Hall on **Wednesday 17th August between 7 and 8 pm** please
7. If three or less entries are received in any class, points will be allocated at the discretion of the judge.
8. **Exhibits must be staged between 9.00am and 11.30am on the day of the show.**
9. **No exhibits will be accepted for staging once the judging has started at 11:30**
10. **Exhibits must not be removed until after the auction. There will be an auction of donated exhibits, following the prize giving. Please support the auction as it ensures the shows continued future.**
11. The committee are not responsible for any loss or damage to display equipment or exhibits.
12. **Children's entries must state age on entry form. Children's staging will be in the Main Hall**
13. **Additional late entries can be made on Friday 19th August between 6 and 7pm in the Village Hall. No further entries accepted after this under any circumstances. No e-mail entries please.**
14. Entries are restricted to **one** per class.
15. *** Visitors are encouraged to make a donation to support the Show on entering at 2:30* .**

HINTS FOR EXHIBITORS.

- Flower arrangements - Sizes where given are important.
- Cookery - Sizes are approximate. No fresh cream may be used as decoration.
- Preserves - New twist tops but not honey jars (unwritten) may be used, wax top not needed. Should be named and dated.
- Lemon curd - Must have cellophane top.
- Jellies - Must be in small jars. Should be named and dated.
- Chutney - New non-metallic lids (unwritten) to be used. Should be named and dated, and least 3 months old.
- Wines - Should be in clear bottles, use shouldered corks, and show year of bottling.
- Photography - Prints can be mounted but not previously exhibited at Ratley Show.
- Art and craft work and writing - must be original and new work produced by the entrant unaided.
