### RULES

1. Open to all residents of Ratley and Edgehill with Upton and Camp Lane, plus visiting children who are relatives of residents of the Parish, or those who work in the Parish or who have a parish allotment.
2. Exhibits must be the property of and/or the unaided work of the exhibitor.
3. Craft items/photographs not to have been exhibited previously at Ratley & District Show.
4. Pot plants must have been in the exhibitor's possession for a minimum period of six months.
5. All Judges are independent of the Flower Show committee. The awarding of points will be at the Judges' discretion alone. The Judges' decision will be final.
6. Entry forms with cash to be handed in by **Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> August** to Adrienne Obbard, 7 Grange Close **OR** at Ratley Village hall on the evening of **Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> August between 7 and 8 o'clock.**
7. **Additional** late entries can be made on **Friday 29<sup>th</sup> August between 6 and 7pm** in the Village Hall.  
**No further entry forms accepted after this under any circumstances. No e-mail entry forms.**
8. If three or less entries are received in any class, points will be allocated at the discretion of the judge.
9. **Exhibits must be staged between 9.00am and 11.30am on the day of the show.**
10. **No exhibits will be accepted for staging once the judging has started at 11:30**
11. **Exhibits must not be removed until after the auction. There will be an auction of donated exhibits, following the prize giving. Please support the auction as it ensures the show continues.**
12. The committee are not responsible for any loss or damage to display equipment or exhibits.
13. **Children's entries must state age on entry form. Children's staging will be in the Main Hall**
14. Entries are restricted to **one** per class.
15. \* **Visitors are encouraged to make a donation to support the Show on entering at 2:30\***

| Flower arrangements | - | Sizes where given are important.   |
| Cookery             | - | Sizes are approximate. <b>No fresh cream may be used as decoration.</b>                                |
| Preserves           | - | Any clear glass jar size or type may be used, wax top not needed. The label should be named and dated. |
| Drinks              | - | Clear glass container with lid, any style.   |
| Lemon curd          | - | Must have cellophane top.  |
| Jellies             | - | Must be in small clear glass jars. Should be named and dated.  |
| Chutney             | - | New non-metallic lids (unwritten) to be used. Should be named and dated, and least 3 months old.       |
| Photography         | - | Prints can be mounted or displayed electronically but not previously exhibited at Ratley Show.         |
| Art and craft work  | - | must be original and new work produced by the entrant unaided.   |
